

Landmark Elementary•Middle School

- Day School for approximately 145 students with language based learning disabilities.
- Serves students in grades 2 - 8
- Located 40 minutes north of Boston in Manchester, Massachusetts.
- Employs generalist tutors and teachers who work 1-1 with students in reading and language tutorials, as well as in small group classes in Language Arts, Oral Expression, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science. Most teachers combine one to one tutoring with small group class assignments.
- New faculty begin teaching in the summer program preceding their first full school year of employment.

Opportunities

- Extensive training and supervision in teaching skills with special emphasis on teaching strategies for students with learning disabilities.
- Valuable teaching experience at one of the nation's most respected schools for students with learning disabilities.
- All new teachers are enrolled in a masters degree (M.Ed.) program in special education through Simmons College. The tuition and fees are paid for by Landmark and all classes are taught on Landmark's campus. The program leads to Massachusetts teacher certification in special needs.

Benefits

- Starting salary for a ten-month teaching contract is 25,000 with added compensation for teaching experience and special needs certification.
