UPCOMING RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS

This week marks the beginning of two very significant religious holidays: Passover for Jews and Holy Week for Christians. The purpose of this announcement is to inform you a little about both.

Passover: This coming Friday evening, April 19, marks the beginning of an eight-day Jewish holiday known as Passover.
